SCHEDULE FOR NESTFEATHER & ANY AGE BIRD SHOW SEPT 21st 2008

- Date:** Sunday 21st September 2008
- Venue:** Nambour State High School...Carroll Street ...Nambour
- Entries:** Will close at 8.00pm, Monday 15th September 08. Entries must be in the hands of **Glen Ford** (07) 54764988 (A/hrs PIs) **Eileen Henricks** (07) 54484035,0408775856 email dachsbirds@eftel.com.au or **Jenny Wicks** 54413349. No late entries will be accepted.
- Staging:** All exhibits must be staged between 7.30 and 8.30am on the day of the show. No exhibits will be accepted for staging unless entry fees are paid. Entry fee of **50 cents** per exhibit will apply.
- Rings:** **Nestfeathers** must be rung with 2008 closed ring and must be owned and bred by the exhibitor, Split rings are not permitted. If the parent club has issued SCBA Inc with a current ring list. Ring Numbers need not be declared on entry form. **SPOT RING CHECKS WILL BE MADE.**
Any Age must be bred and owned by the exhibitor in the **OPEN, INTERMEDIATE, NOVICE SECTIONS**
- Labels:** To be affixed to bottom right hand corner of cage. Class labels and exhibitors portion will be posted at a cost of 50 cents unless otherwise stated.
- Rules:** The show will be conducted under the rules of the Sunshine Coast Budgerigar Assoc Inc as interpreted by the Show Committee (ie SQBBA rules). All exhibitors acknowledge acceptance of these rules as a condition of entry. Purchased birds: Cannot be shown.
- Cages:** Only show cages which meet the A.N.B.C. show cage specification will be accepted. Old cages with black bow fronts are not acceptable and will be disqualified if staged. Any birds in dirty, marked or damaged cages will not be considered for awards. The Show Manager will inspect all cages prior to judging. All entries will be paid for. **Please ensure drinkers are in correct position.**
- Seed:** All Show Cages will contain a seed mixture suitable for budgerigars. No seed such as sunflower seed is to be used.
- Judging:** Judging will commence at 9.00am sharp. The judge's decision will be final in all matters of merit.
- Exhibits:** All birds will be considered the property of the Association during the period of the show and they must not be touched or taken away without the permission of the Show Manager. All birds entered are at the sole risk of the exhibitor and the Association will not be held responsible for loss or injury.
- Morning tea:** Morning Tea will be provided free
- Lunch:** Will be available at a nominal fee.
- Awards:** Presentation of Awards will take place immediately after lunch.
- Removal:** Removal of birds shall be directly following presentation.
- Bird Sale** Exhibitors, who are interested in selling birds through our Bird Sale, are encouraged to provide healthy, young birds to a value of \$75.00. Two birds per cage, either pairs or same sex birds,(Maximum 8 birds per breeder) bidding for these birds are done thru interested parties placing their name along side the birds, if more than one person interested, the highest card drawn from a pack, will purchase the birds 10% commission is paid to the SCBA Inc. 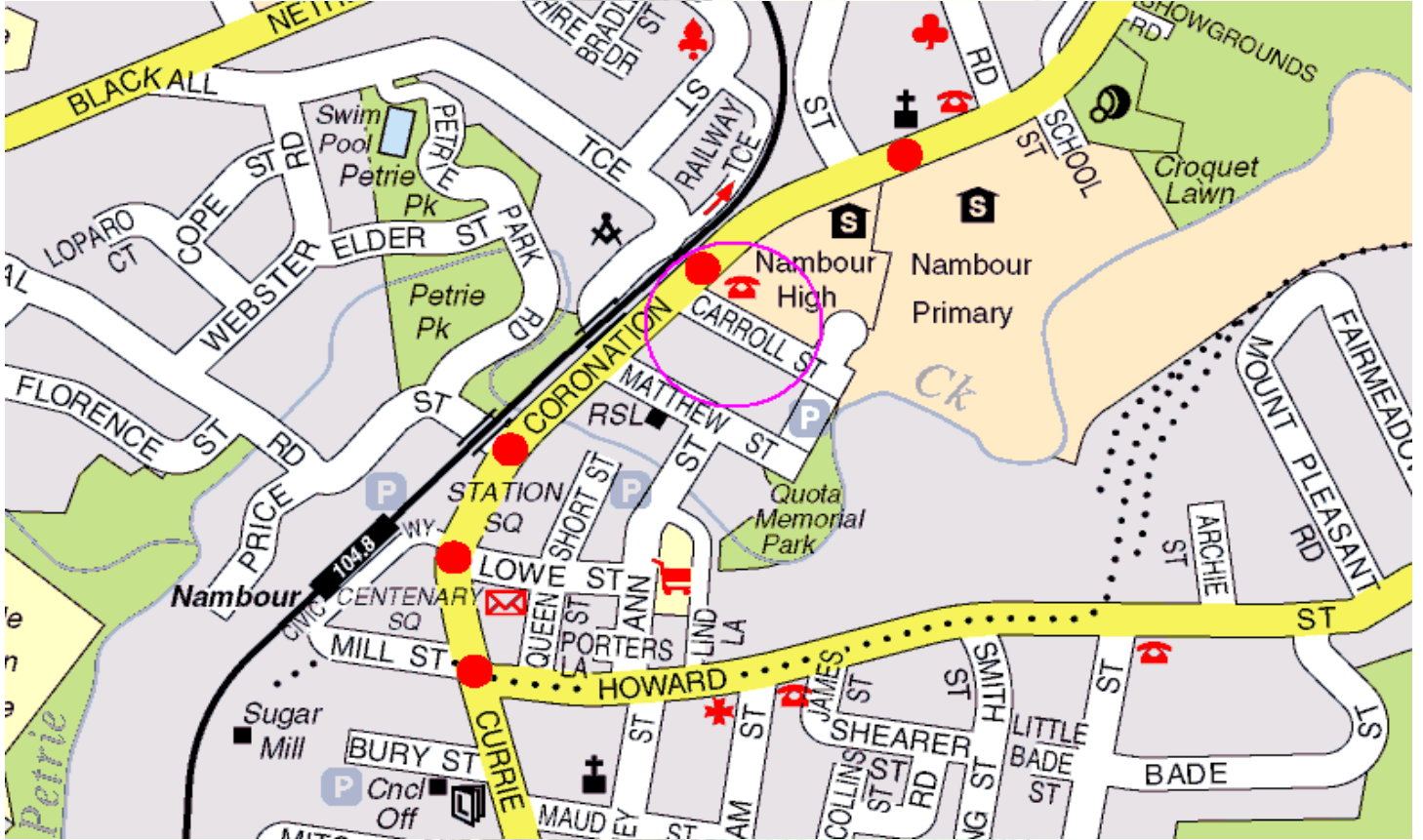
